

Every EAF Club may enter the

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS 2022

The Championships are Club-based competitions, rather like a 'battle'. Each Club needs 25 PDIs and/or 15 Prints from a minimum of just 5 members, so even the smallest Clubs can take part.

There are two Championships each year – one in Projected Digital Images (PDI) and one in Prints. The Championships will find the top EAF Club and select the top two Clubs to represent the EAF at the PAGB Club Championships later in 2022.

The next Championships will be at The Fulbourn Centre (Townley Memorial Hall), 31 Home End, Fulbourn, Cambridge CB21 5BS:

PDI – 13th February 2022, starting after the 10.30am EAF AGM (Championship will not start before 11.30am)

and

Prints – 13th March 2022, start 10.45am

We'd love to see new Clubs enter in 2022 as well as the regulars. Come to see other Clubs' best work from around the EAF. Come to chat to other Club members and make new friends.

If you are thinking about going for a photographic award of merit (CPAGB, DPAGB or MPAGB) this will be a good opportunity to see the sort of images that tend to do well. Your Club doesn't have to enter for you to come to see what goes on.

Everyone is welcome.

The Championships entry forms and spectator ticket applications are available on the EAF website, www.eaf.org.uk under "Downloadable Documents" on the "Info" tab. Note that due to pandemic restrictions tickets to attend in person are limited but the event will be Zoomed so you could apply for tickets to see it that way. Two tickets have been reserved for each Club entering and then after the deadline for entries, three weeks before the event, they will be on general sale.
