## EAF ENGAGEMENT DAY 'DUXFORD 2026'

### **'6-from-6' Entry Rules – Closing date 18<sup>th</sup> May 2026**

## 1.0 Compliance with the rules

1.0.1 You agree to abide by these rules when entering the '6 from 6' competition.

It is your responsibility to ensure that you have done so. However, it is expected that your Club will check your entry for compliance before making the Club's overall submission.

1.0.2 Failure to comply with the rules may disqualify your entry.

1.0.3 The club accepts responsibility for GDPR compliance of the entry.

## 1.1 Entry

1.1.1 Entry will be carried out by the Club's nominated representative.

1.1.2 Entries shall be made by the Club representative using the 'PhotoEntry' competition management system.

Full details – and a log-in facility – are available on request via the EAF Website. The Club representative will be allocated a log-in Username and Password for the Club for use with the system.

1.1.3 Entry shall be completed by the Club's representative at the latest by the stated closing date.

1.1.4 Whilst every precaution is taken with entries, the EAF cannot accept any responsibility for loss or damage to physical entries or electronically transmitted items.

1.1.5 This competition has THREE sections. Each section has TWO entries by different authors.

**THEREFORE, YOUR CLUB WILL NEED A TOTAL OF SIX DIFFERENT IMAGES, ALL BY DIFFERENT AUTHORS – HENCE '6 FROM 6'.**

2 off Colour or Mono Print – Mounted or Unmounted – Printed A3 or A4

2 off Colour or Mono Projected Digital Images image ((PDIs)).

2 off Mobile Phone Projected Digital Images (PDIs)

The PDI image pixel dimensions entered shall have a maximum horizontal dimension of 1600 pixels and a maximum vertical dimension of 1200 pixels.

File Type: Standard JPEG. Colourspace : sRGB (IEC 61966-2-1:1999).

1.1.6 Within each section, images may be any theme and in any genre.

1.1.7 Prints must have their Title, Entrant's Name and Club Name printed clearly on the reverse— as close to the Top Right-Hand Corner as practicable when viewed from the rear of the print.

1.1.8 Each entered Print must be supplied with a PDI copy file, uploaded using the 'PhotoEntry' competition management system., this will be used for record purposes, management of the event, and to display during the critique feedback session.

## 2.1 Image Eligibility.

2.1.1 All images, and components of images, entered must be the Copyright of the Club member making the entry and must originate from photographic capture.

2.1.2 The use of third-party Clip-Art or any other image or image component such as Royalty Free content is not permitted if not originally captured photographically by the entrant.

**2.1.3 The use of AI generated images or components of images is not permitted.**

**2.1.4 The use of Processing Tools where there is an AI element which assists the efficiency of the tool, but where the entrant is in complete control of the output is permitted. Any generation of new pixels within the image by the AI assisted tool must be based on the existing pixels within the image.**
